Peregrino, Sauvignon Blanc. 14.20 3.30 3.80 4.80
Chile (1)
 Zingy, crisp acidity packed with Granny Smith apple flavours.

Kleindal, 'Bouquet Blanc' Muscat de Frontignan Colombard. 14.75 3.40 3.90 4.90
South Africa (3)
 Refreshing, medium wine showing over-ripe peaches and nectarines with a clean, citrus finish.

GPG Pinot Grigio Garganega. 14.75 3.40 3.90 4.90
Italy (1)
 Lightly aromatic with ripe citrus and baked apple characters. Easy to drink with soft, honeyed fruit and a fresh finish.

Euca Hill, Chardonnay. 14.75 3.40 3.90 4.90
Australia (2)
 Notes of pear with an interesting integration of oak, and nicely rounded with a pleasingly clingy finish.

Kenton Estate White. 17.95 3.95 4.95 6.50
England (2)
 Grown and produced on the banks of Devon's Exe Estuary, this vibrant and beautifully aromatic local wine is delectably fresh and minerally with marked elderflower and hedgerow characteristics.

Gold County, Zinfandel Blush. 14.20 3.30 3.80 4.80

 Delicious Californian rose with summer fruits and a hint of sweetness on the finish.

Liso Viente Garnacha Rosado. 14.20 3.30 3.80 4.80
Spain (2)
 An easy going rosé with attractive strawberry fruit. Juicy and fresh, with a crisp, clean finish.

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Red Wines

Peregrino, Merlot. 14.20 3.30 3.80 4.80
Chile (B)
 Straightforward, easy drinking with a soft mouth feel and a plummy finish.

Euca Hill, Shiraz. 14.75 3.40 3.90 4.90
Australia (C)
 Beautiful red fruit tones such as morello cherries and rich raspberries, complimented by a complex, spicy bite.

Finca Clasica, Malbec Shiraz. 14.95 3.50 3.95 4.95
Argentina (D)
 A blend of two full bodied grape varieties grown at the highest vineyards in the world offering a deeply coloured red with a soft, easy going palate of well-constructed fruit and a long pleasant finish.

Rioja Vega Señorial, Tinto Rioja DOCa. 16.20 3.60 4.20 5.50
Spain (C)
 Dark crimson in colour with violet hues and well-assembled, red fruit aromas. Structured, rounded and balanced on the palate.

Portugal (50ml serving)
 Damsons and warm spice on the nose with a complex palate, with hints of cherry.
